1. MICHAEL HENDERSON, RUBY, NEW YORK OPERATES THE BMX TRACK IN THE CITY OF KINGSTON. WANTED TO THANK THE ALDERMEN FOR CONSIDERING THE RENEWAL AGREEMENT TO KEEP THE TRACK OPEN.
 2. JOEY ALBRIGHT, MT. MARION, NEW YORK. WOULD ALSO LIKE TO THANK THE ALDERMEN FOR CONSIDERING THE RENEWAL CONTRACT. BMX TURNED HIS LIFE AROUND AS A YOUTH.
 3. PAUL MAGLIATO, HIGHLAND, NEW YORK. READ A LETTER FROM HIS DAUGHTER ABOUT THE POSITIVE INFLUENCE BMX HAS HAD ON HER LIFE, SHE IS CURRENTLY THIRD IN EAST COAST COMPETITION. HE TALKED OF THE MANY HOURS VOLUNTEERING, THAT THE ATMOSPHERE IS CLEAN AND FAMILY ORIENTED.
 4. MARYANN DONALDSON, 6 ELIZABETH ST., KINGSTON. SPOKE ON HOW FAMILY ORIENTED AND SAFE THE TRACK IS. IT IS A DIAMOND IN THE ROUGH THAT IF EXPANDED COULD OFFER NATIONAL OR EAST COAST COMPETITIONS WHICH WOULD GENERATE REVENUE FOR THE CITY.
 5. THOMAS GRAGA, 43 CRANE ST., KINGSTON. SPOKE HOW THE HENDERSONS HAVE WORKED VERY HARD OVER THE YEARS TO MAINTAIN THE TRACK. HE HAS TWO SONS IN COMPETITION WHO LOVE THE COMPETITION. TRACK BRINGS PEOPLE FROM OUT OF THE AREA INTO KINGSTON.
 6. GIL SPIEKER, WALLKILL, NEW YORK. HE HAS THREE SONS WHO COMPETE AND WHO WOULD HAVE NO PLACE TO PRACTICE IF THE TRACK WASN'T THERE.
 7. AMY GIGLIUTO, CLINTONDALE, NEW YORK. NEW PALTZ BMX AND KINGSTON BMX WORK TOGETHER, ALL THE PARENTS VOLUNTEER TO MAINTAIN TRACK. THE HENDERSONS HAVE DEDICATED THEIR LIVES TO THE CHILDREN.
 8. JUSTIN LEDOUX, WALLKILL, NEW YORK. HE HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN BMX FOR 18 YEARS IT IS A WONDERFUL ATMOSPHERE FOR KIDS, KEEPS THEM OFF THE STREET. EVEN CHILDREN WITH CERTAIN HANDICAPS CAN BE INVOLVED.
 9. CLARK RICHTERS, 3 GARRAGHAN DR., KINGSTON, NEW YORK. A SUPPORTER OF THE BMX TRACK, SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR CHILDREN, KEEPS THEM OFF THE STREET.
 10. PHILIP GURRIERI, 28 DIETZ CT., KINGSTON, NEW YORK. IF THE DOCK SPACE WAS NOT USED THE TRACK COULD BE EXPANDED, WOULD HAVE A BETTER TRACK.
 11. DOMINICK VANACORE, N. FRONT ST., KINGSTON, NEW YORK SPOKE ABOUT THE TRAFFIC PILOT PROGRAM. STATED THAT UPTOWN KINGSTON DOESN'T GET ENOUGH SUPPORT FROM THE CITY AND IT IS THE JEWEL OF THE CITY. ENCOURAGED ALDERMEN TO ACCOMPANY HIM ON A WALKING TOUR OF THE AREA.

THE CITY HAS FORGOTTEN THE TRACK AND NOT PROMOTED BY THE CITY. WE HAVE A SISTER TRACK IN KINGSTON, ONTARIO WERE MANY OF OUR CHILDREN COMPETE.
 13. MRS. VANDYKE, NEW JERSEY, WIFE AND MOTHER OF BMX RACERS. THE HENDERSON FAMILY HAS BEEN WONDERFUL AND THEY MAKE YOU FEEL AT HOME. SOME CHILDREN ASPIRE TO COMPETE IN THE OLYMPICS IN BMX COMPETITION AND THE KINGSTON TRACK IS AN EXCELLENT TRAINING AREA.
 14. AVERY VANDYKE, NEW JERSEY. IS A COMPETITOR AND WOULD BE HEARTBROKEN IF THE TRACK WAS TO CLOSE. EVERYONE WOULD LOSE.
