Upon receipt of all monies, and signing of the closing document by the purchaser and the Mayor, the Corporation Counsel Office will prepare and file a quitclaim deed with the County Clerk's Office;

- 7. The City of Kingston reserves the right to reject all bids received;

For all properties acquired by tax foreclosure, the City of Kingston will require a separate fixed payment of \$1,200.00 for administrative costs at closing, or an amount prescribed in the most recent City of Kingston Fee Schedule for properties acquired through the "in rem" tax lien foreclosure process.
