

**LOCAL LAW 3 OF 2021 OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK,  
AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF A NEW CHAPTER ENTITLED  
COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATION (ENERGY) PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, a request has been made to add a new Chapter 18 entitled Community Choice Aggregation (Energy) Program thereby establishing a Community Choice Aggregation Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Choice Aggregation allows municipalities to provide bulk electricity rates to residents and businesses by pooling demand, resulting in lower energy costs and more affordable green energy.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Common Council authorizes the adoption of a new Chapter 18 entitled Community Choice Aggregation (Energy) Program to the Code of the City of Kingston as annexed hereto.

**SECTION 2.** If any provisions of this local law are held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the local law shall remain in effect.

**SECTION 3.** This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
