

APPLIANCES, FURNITURE, MATTRESS/BOX SPRINGS

To place curbside must purchase tag/sticker from DPW Administrative Office

Sleeper Sofa must have metal removed

Can be brought to Transfer Station. Reduced fee applies

ELECTRONICS/COMPUTERS

To place curbside must purchase tag/sticker from DPW Administrative Office

Can be brought to Transfer Station FREE of charge

CARPETS

Must be rolled and no longer than 4 ft. in length

Must be placed in brown tote

METAL

Collected on last Friday of each month unless week has a holiday

EXCAVATIONS/SIDEWALKS/DUMPSTERS

Any City street or public right of way needing excavation or a sidewalk repair or replacement or placement of dumpster on sidewalk or City street, must have an approved permit from the Dept. of Public Works. Applications available at the administrative office or the City website. A minimum of 48 hours is required.

REFUSE TOTE (Brown)

One brown refuse tote of any size up to 96 gallons will be provided for the following:

Single, Two, Three, Family also Four or more family and/or commercial and or manufacturing properties

Pick up weekly on assigned trash day

Any of the above may elect to have an additional tote(s) at a set annual fee. Contact DPW office for details.

Only refuse placed in brown tote will be picked up curbside.

ALL TOTES: Handle must be placed with handle facing in towards home.

Keep clear of all over head obstructions

3ft x 3ft space must be cleared curbside for each

Receptacle placed curbside

ITEMS NOT COLLECTED CURBSIDE

Auto parts; Motor Oil; Tires

Paint cans (with liquid paint)

Propane Tank; Flammable liquids or Acid

Batteries; Poisons

Waste not generated in the City of Kingston

Fluorescent light bulbs

Contractor 's or construction debris

Refuse not generated in City of Kingston

Containers over 50 lbs.

Damaged or faulty receptacles

Industrious, infectious or chemical waste

Debris resulting from but not limited to relocation, evictions and household cleaning

Dead animals

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

All recyclable materials combined in blue tote

(plastic, glass, paper and cardboard)

Opposite week pick up from yard waste

Residents without blue tote picked up weekly

- Over flow recycling may be placed in a marked container & placed next to blue recycling tote

YES

Milk/Fruit Juice Cartons if unwaxed

Plastic Bottles, Tubs, Jugs and Jars (#1-#7)

Glass Bottles, Aluminum Cans & Jars

Lids from Glass Bottles or Jars

Paper Egg Cartons

Thin Cardboard Boxes (cereal etc.)

Corrugated Cardboard and Paper Bags

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, Junk Mail &

Office Paper, phone books, wrapping paper

Hard backed books

Hint: Look for code on container. If it has this symbol it is recyclable



NO

Plastic bags (such as from supermarket)

Scrap Metal; Pizza Boxes, Shredded Paper

Frozen Food Boxes if no recycling emblem

Ceramic or Non-Recyclable Glass

Hazardous Waste/Diapers

Light Bulbs, Drinking or Window Glass

Styrofoam or paper to-go containers

YARD WASTE

Alternate Weeks with Single Stream Recycling

Grass clippings, leaves, garden debris, small branches

- Collected March 12 – November 9 **NO PLASTIC BAGS**
- No contractor's debris

BRUSH

Alternate Weeks with Single Stream Recycling

Tree pruning, shrubs and large branches

- Collected Apr 9 to Jun 22 & Sep 24 to Oct 12
- No items over 4' in length or 3" in diameter
- Branches/pruning's must be bundled and tied

WOOD

- Collected Apr 9 to Jun 8 & Sep 4 to Oct 12
- Picked up every week on regular trash day
- No items over 4 foot in length or 3 inches diameter
- Will only be picked up in brown tote
- No contractor's debris

LEAVES

- Collection Nov 5—Dec 7 **Plastic Bags NOT accepted**
- Will be picked up on normal trash day during yard waste week

ELECTRONICS

If placed curbside must purchase tag from DPW Office **OR**

May be taken free of charge to Transfer Station
