REFUSE - Picked up Weekly on regular trash day
 * Only refuse in brown tote will be collected.
 * Any trash outside brown tote may be subject to violations
 * No items may be left outside brown tote for pick up
 * No yard waste can be placed in brown refuse tote
 * No hazardous material accepted

RECYCLING - GLASS, PLASTIC & METAL - BLUE SHADED WEEK
 * Opposite week of Paper & Cardboard (yellow shaded)
 Items Accepted - Glass jars, bottles, tin or steel cans, plastic bottles & containers, aluminum, cans

RECYCLING - PAPER & CARDBOARD - YELLOW SHADED WEEK
 * Opposite week of Glass, Plastic & Metal (blue shaded)
 Items Accepted - Cereal boxes, paper towel rolls, cardboard, telephone books, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, paper bags office paper, file folders, newspapers and inserts. **NO SHREDDED PAPER**

MISCELLANEOUS CURBSIDE PICK UP
 * Furniture/Mattress/Box Spring/Appliances - to put curbside, a fee of \$25 or \$35 PER ITEM, must be paid beforehand. Payment is accepted at DPW Admin Offices at 25 E. O'Reilly St. Mon-Fri 8am - 4pm by check or credit card
 * Lesser fee applies if brought to Transfer Station by resident
 * Electronics at curb - \$20 regardless of size, must be paid beforehand, --FREE if brought to the Transfer Station by resident

TRANSFER STATION - Some Fees May Apply
 380 Boulevard (behind UC Jail) 845-331-5787
 Accepted: yard waste, refuse, e-waste and recycling
 Hours Year Round Fri 9am to 1pm & Sat 8am to 3pm (Sat hrs if staffing allows)

YARD WASTE, BRUSH - Picked up April 15 to November 29
 * Grass clippings, leaves, garden debris, small chipped branches - Must be containerized or in bio-degradable bag
 * Tree pruning, shrubs, large branches
 * Branches no larger than 4ft in length and 3in diameter - **ALL BRANCHES NEED TO BE BUNDLED**
 * Yard Waste cannot be put in brown refuse tote
 * Yard Waste is Picked Up on Fridays
 If your trash day is MONDAY OR TUESDAY Yard Waste Picked Up Friday On **BLUE SHADED WEEK**
 If your trash day is WEDNESDAY OR THURSDAY Yard Waste Picked Up Friday On **YELLOW SHADED WEEK**
IF TRASH IS DELAYED A DAY- YARD WASTE PICK UP WILL BE SATURDAY

LEAVES - Picked up October 21 to November 29
 * NO loose leaves
 * NO leaves raked to curb
 * Must be in bio-degradable bag or containerized
 * Snow or other emergency events may cause leaf pick up to end on an earlier date
 * Leaves and garden debris can be taken to Transfer Station YEAR ROUND for FREE, excluding contractors (see fee schedule)

LUMBER/SMALL FURNITURE - Picked up April 15 to December 1
 * Furniture - Only what fits in brown tote - can be broken up to fit in tote; if left outside the tote, a furniture fee will apply
 * NO lumber, or construction material will be taken curbside or at Transfer Station
 * All lumber and construction debris must be taken to UCRRA Rt 32 Kingston

CHRISTMAS TREES - Jan 2 to Jan 26
 * Please remove all ornaments, decorations, tinsel, hanging apparatus, fasteners, lights and stands
 * Wreaths must be disassembled, no wire, metal or plastic rings allowed
