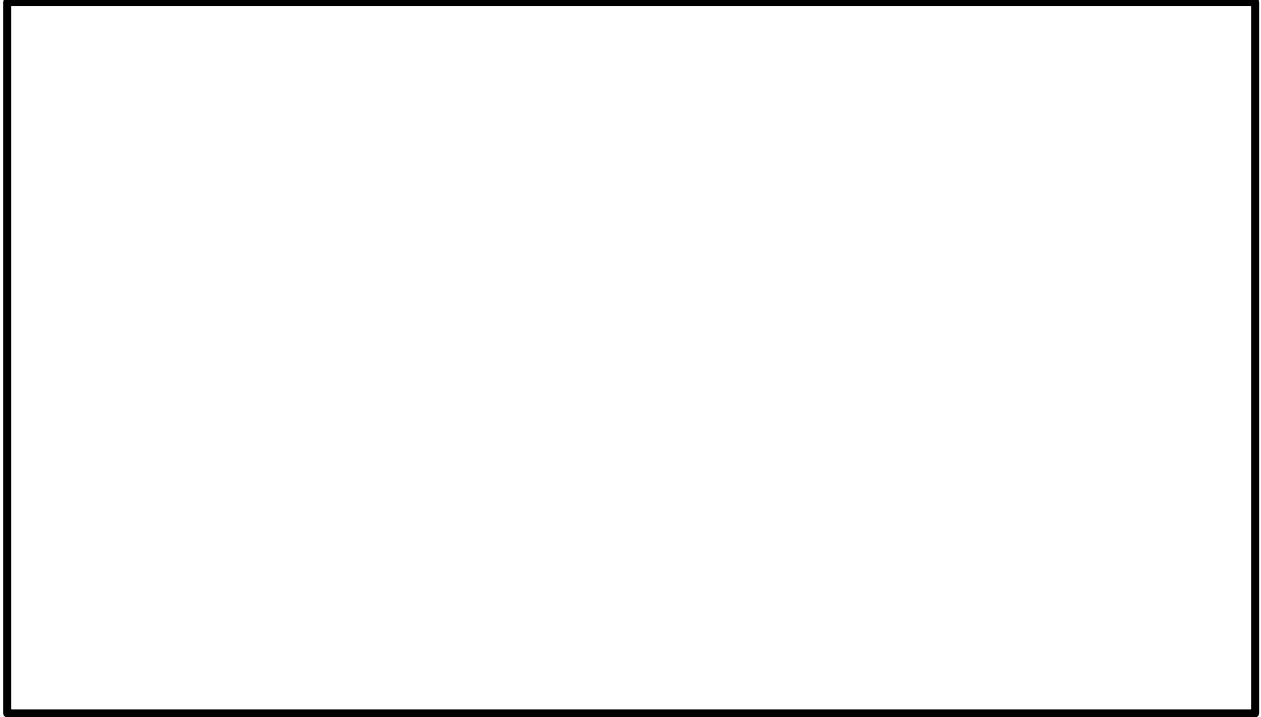


Tracks and Scat Discovery
