**Clue #4:** I am the longest New York snake. For dinner I'd like an animal whose name is also in my name.

**Clue #5:** Farmers gave me my name because I live inside their barns. They thought I survive on a liquid diet, but for dinner I'd actually prefer one of these small furry barn animals instead.

**Clue #6:** I am a brightly colored snake, but I'm actually really good at camouflage and blend in well with the grass. For dinner I'd like an animal with more legs than an insect.

**Clue #7:** From my name, you'd think I was royal. For dinner I'd like an aquatic animal that looks like a lobster.
