

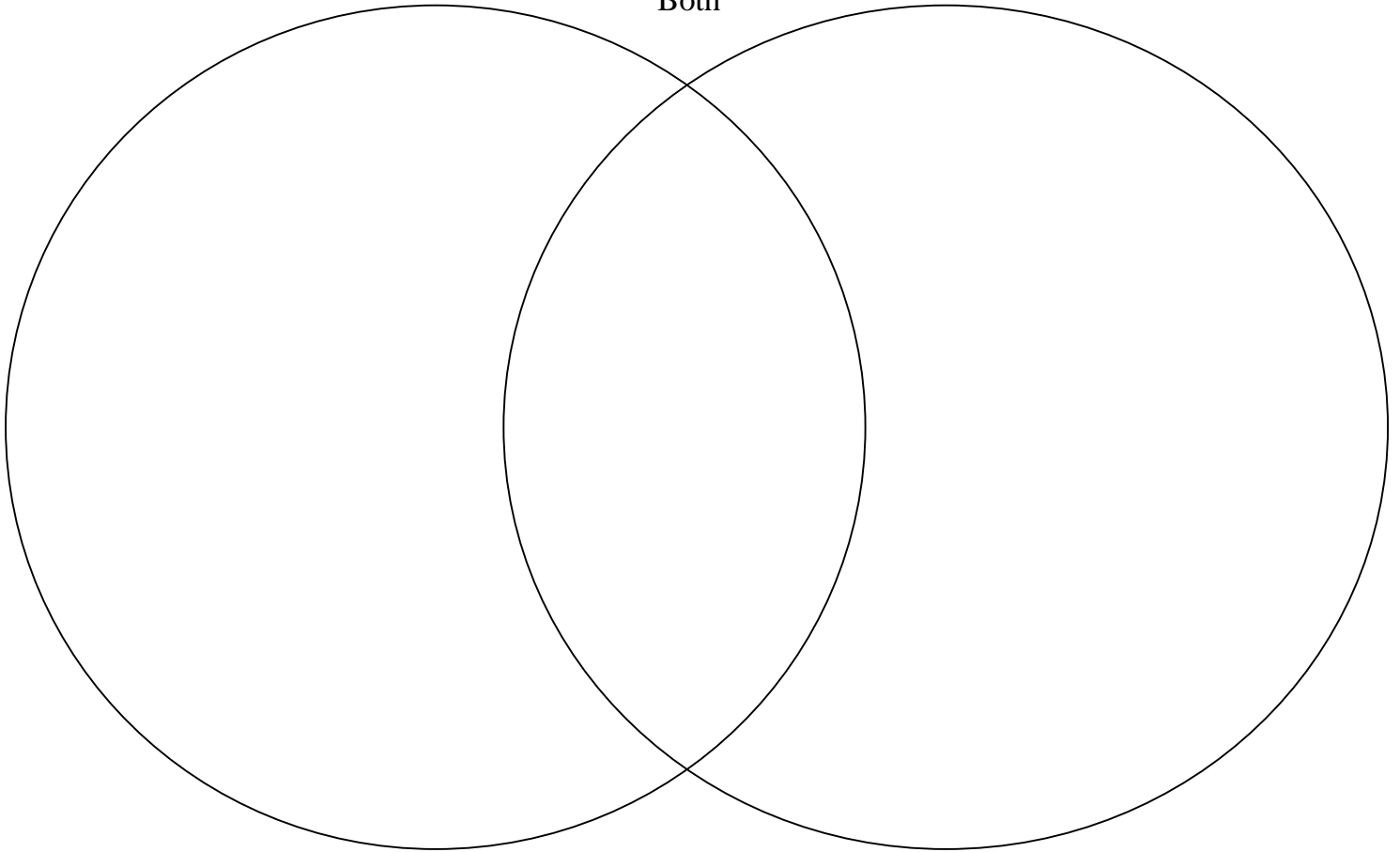
Tree Compare and Contrast
