- Max fee: \$3000/unit Approx. \$417,000
- Final recommendation- No fee (5/6 commissioners)
- Al Nance recused himself due to ethics committee conflict of interest—the belief the options
  available to vote may present a possible filing of an ethics complaint.
- Joe M recommended "a numbered breakdown" for future decision-making regarding parkland/recreation fee
