RESOLUTION NO. 2501

RE: Authorizing and Approving the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency charges for Hard Mix

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency (the “Agency”) is engaged in Solid Waste Management and Recycling in Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, the Agency approved Resolution No. 2455 dated June 27, 2018 discontinuing service of single stream recyclables on December 31, 2018,

WHEREAS, the Agency has been receiving Hard Mix at the Agency’s transfer stations in New Paltz and Kingston, and

WHEREAS, the Agency had to at its own cost and expense pay to dispose of same at Republic Industries, Beacon, New York,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency will only accept Hard Mix Recyclables at its facilities for a price set each month by the Executive Director, by calculating the average rate the Agency was charged to remove single stream recyclables in the previous month, plus a \$15.00 per ton fee reflecting the Agency’s cost of storing and handling such material, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect on June 1, 2020.
