City of Kingston Launches Weekend Shuttle Services

(Kingston, N.Y.) Mayor Steve Noble is pleased to announce the launch of a new, low-cost shuttle service to transport residents and visitors through Kingston's business districts.

"We have so many wonderful and unique businesses in our community. I want to help make it easier for people to visit these locations and enjoy the products and services only Kingston can offer," said Mayor Noble. "I'm excited to launch this weekend shuttle and encourage residents and visitors to enjoy this new service for the rest of the summer and into the fall."

The Shuttle will operate Friday evenings, from 5:30pm-10:30pm, and Saturdays, from Noon-10:00pm. Pick up locations will be at or near:

- Intersection of North Front St. and Wall St.
- 721 Broadway
- Ulster Performing Arts Center (601 Broadway)
- Yosman Towers (295 Broadway)
- Heritage Area Visitors Center/Ulster County Tourism (20 Broadway)
- Intersection of North St. and Delaware Avenue (Saturdays Only)
- Kingston Point Beach (Saturdays Only)

The shuttle will operate on a continuous loop and will allow "hop on, hop off" service to riders along the route. Instead of a per-ride fee, riders can access the shuttle as many times as they would like during the service times for a one-time cost of \$2 for the entire day.

"We're excited to work with our partners in the business community to promote the availability of this new, low-cost way to move around Kingston," said Mayor Noble. "I plan to hop on this weekend to visit the Farmer's Market, Smorgasburg and a few other places along the way."
