

Budget Overview

- 3 new positions year over year
- Low Fiscal Stress Score
- 9th year under the Tax Cap
- Total Rec. Budget \$52,207,123

Holding the line on discretionary spending

2023: \$8,131,768

2024: \$8,115,406

Decrease of \$16,362

In 2023, Tax Levy was reduced \$50,000

In 2024, \$341,029 Tax Levy increase

Modest change in the Homestead Rate from \$8.81 to \$8.98

(per thousand)

Slight increase in the Non-Homestead Rate from \$13.91 to \$14.09

(per thousand)


Tax Rates Declined for 8 Years


City Tax Rates per \$1,000




H = Homestead **NH** = Non-Homestead


